How We Care

2022 brought some relief from COVID-19 and allowed us at GMCC to focus intently on **care**-- for our patients and each other.

Our patients faced many challenges beyond their health concerns. The GMCC team helped them meet their needs for food, social services, and more. We are successfully providing integrated health care in the Clinic, with many services available under one roof.

At the same time, we realized the impact of the global health emergency on the mental well-being of our own staff and volunteers, and were able to provide mental health and resiliency training thanks to a partnership with the Virginia Association of Free and Charitable Clinics (VAFCC) and Project HOPE.



2022 Highlights

- CJ Badger, RN joined the GMCC care team as Director of Patient Care. Her commitment to meeting patients' needs has resulted in evening appointment hours as well a monthly popup clinic in Mathews.
- The Clinic celebrated a hybrid spring fundraiser-- a Cinco de Mayo dinner to go-- and held our 12th annual Golf Classic. We got together in person for an Oktoberfest celebration and were thrilled to honor some Clinic heroes once again.
- Our pharmacy team went through a major change this year after our devoted pharmacist of 13 years, Kerry Danaceau, was in an accident. Pharmacists Rick Allen and Tom Pachla came out of retirement to keep pharmacy operations running smoothly. With the addition of pharmacist Jennifer Foster, they now provide medication counseling, smoking cessation resources, and a host of services to patients at GMCC.
- The Dental team, in collaboration with HELP Dental Clinic in Hampton, began using 3D printing technology to manufacture dentures and mouth guards for patients. This life-changing technology allows patients to acquire dentures at an affordable cost.



Who We Serve & How


About 40% of families in Gloucester and Mathews counties struggle to afford the basic necessities of living. Once housing, food, transportation, and child care are paid for, there is often little room in the budget for health care, including health insurance and medications. Most GMCC patients are employed but lack access to health insurance through their employers. GMCC helps families get the care and medications they need.

Clinic Hero Spotlight: Louise Theberge



Her introduction to GMCC was made during her years of service as a local leader in government. When she left the Gloucester Board of Supervisors in 2014, her friend Ann Quinn (for whom the GMCC Dental Clinic is dedicated) invited her to join the board at the Clinic. Two years later, Louise took the reins as President, and led the Clinic through a period of great transition. During her tenure on the GMCC Board, the Clinic: survived the closure, search for funding, and reopening of its dental clinic; achieved certification to treat Medicaid patients; and helped patients manage their health through a pandemic. "I've enjoyed my time at the Clinic," she says, smiling wryly. "It's been... educational." Joking aside, Louise admits that she knew very little about the people we serve until she joined the Board. "Seeing the difficulties our patients face-- and how easy it is to slip into uninsured status-- makes you really appreciate your own insurance benefits. The degree of impact-- just how fast and far the effects of going without healthcare reach-- is severe. I'm grateful for my time on the Board, and to have been able to be of service."

Louise is retiring to the west coast this year and will be sorely missed, but her legacy of service to our community will live on!




WILLIAMSBURG Health UNDATION
