2024 In The Clinic

- In keeping with our mission statement, we began offering in-house lab services in 2024. This partnership with LabCorp fills a need not only for GMCC patients, but for *everyone* in our community. The lab is available to anyone who has lab orders from LabCorp, regardless of insurance status.
- Patrick Watson, DMD joined the staff as our new volunteer dental provider.
- We bid a fond farewell to Dr. Wendell Poulsen, who retired after serving as the Clinic's Practice Manager for the past 9 years.
- Our friends (and new neighbors!) from Langley Federal Credit Union participated in the Martin Luther King Day of Service by volunteering at the Clinic. Thanks to their efforts, our patient screening lobby and administrative offices received a much-needed new coat of paint.

Dr. Patrick Watson is the newest member of GMCC's small but mighty dental team. He shares a family dentistry practice with his father in Newport News, and has had a passion for helping others through dentistry since his first years in practice. When Dr. Watson learned of the need at GMCC for volunteer dentists, he didn't hesitate! He sees patients on Friday mornings. The work is a little different at GMCC than in private practice-- without any hygienists, dentists do teeth cleanings. And many of our patients have suffered for months or years with broken teeth or serious pain before coming in to get care. The relief they experience through treatment is Dr. Watson's favorite part of volunteering.

Who We Serve & How

About **32%** of families in Gloucester and Mathews counties struggle to afford the basic necessities of living. Once housing, food, transportation, and child care are paid for, there is often little room in the budget for health insurance and medications.

Most GMCC patients are employed, but they lack access to health insurance through their employers.

GMCC helps families get the care and medications they need.

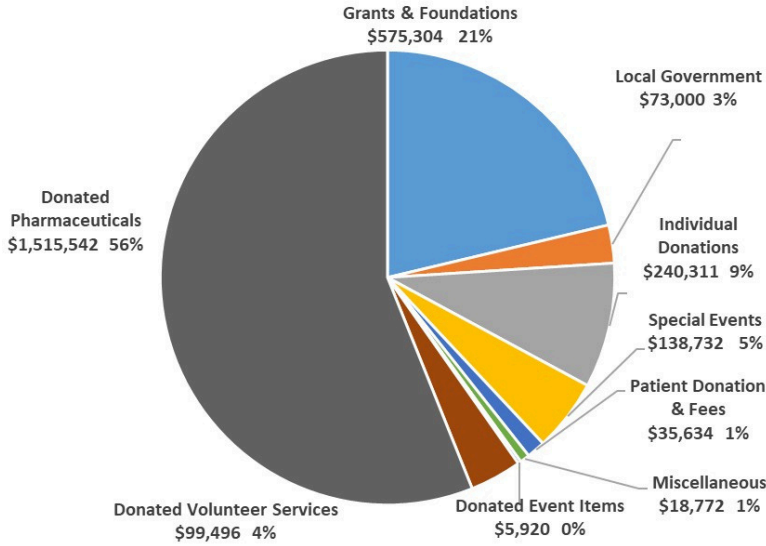

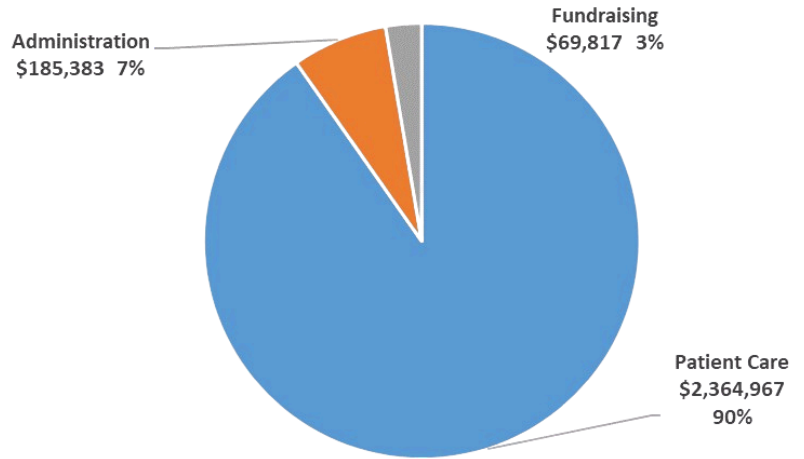
